**Be sure to attach ALL required documents.**

Kinder Roundup will be at FDS for incoming Kindergarten assessments. Please know Roundup is **ONLY** for incoming **KINDER**. All students TK and Kinder will need to register for the school year. Registration will be available **ONLINE ONLY** beginning Monday 2/14/2022, [www.fusd.org](http://www.fusd.org) "New Student online registration". Make sure to select our next school year 22/23. Please know that this must be completed as well as **ALL** required documents turned in to be called for your scheduled assessment time, if you do not submit all of the forms required your child **will not** be fully registered until we have them, please call (530) 367-3782 with any questions.

### **Important Dates:**

\*If your child will turn **5 on or before 9/1/22**, please register for Kindergarten. Your child will begin school on the first day of school, tentatively set on Thursday 08/18/2022.

\*If your child will turn **5 between 9/2/22-2/2/23**, please register for TK. Your child will begin school on the first day of school, tentatively set on Thursday 08/18/2022.

\*If your child will turn **5 between 2/3/23-4/1/23**, a waiting list will be developed. **It is important that you still complete the registration.** We **may** admit a child to **TK** who has his/her 5<sup>th</sup> birthday **after** 2/2/23 but during the same school year, on a case-by-case, based on space availability and in order of the student birthdate.

### **What is Transitional Kindergarten (TK)?**

- TK is taught by credentialed teachers and there is no cost for TK.
- TK will prepare students for Kindergarten and success with the California Common Core State Standards.
- TK students are part of the larger school community and will follow the same schedule as regular Kindergarten classes.
- TK students will be able to attend all school sponsored assemblies/activities found to be developmentally appropriate.
