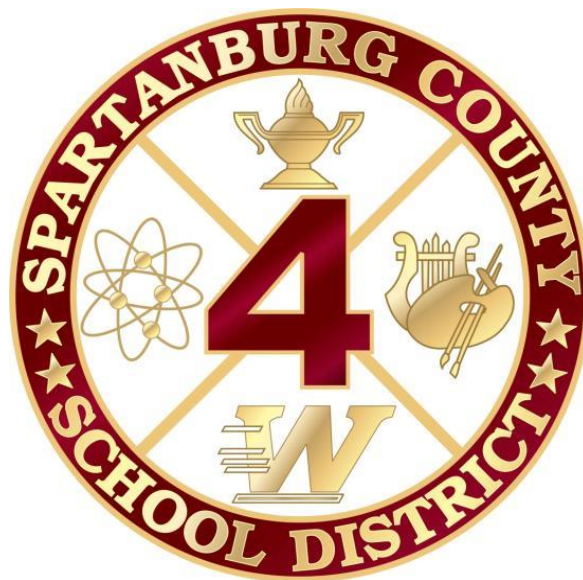


**Spartanburg School

Return to School Plan
2021-2022**

SECTION ONE:

1. Spartanburg Four staff and students will not be required to wear masks for the 2021-2022 school year. Any staff or student who chooses to wear a mask will be allowed to do so.
2. Spartanburg District Four students will maintain social distance practices whenever possible based on the space or area.
3. Hand sanitizer stations will continue to be placed in common areas for staff and student use. Hand sanitizer will be provided for classrooms, restrooms, and common areas.
4. Spartanburg Four will continue to maintain clean facilities and use proper cleaning supplies to provide a healthy environment for staff and students.
5. The maintenance staff will continue to have routine air quality checks by maintaining state of the art HVAC systems and changing filters.
6. Spartanburg Four will continue to do contact tracing for staff and students who have come in contact with a positive case of COVID-19. Any staff or student who has been in contact with a positive case will be required to quarantine. Any staff or student who tests positive for COVID-19 will be required to isolate. *Quarantine and Isolation periods will be determined by the latest recommendation from DHEC.
7. Spartanburg Four will not test staff and students for COVID-19 for the 2021-2022 school year.
8. All staff and students are encouraged to receive the vaccination for COVID-19, but it is not required to work or attend school.

SECTION TWO:

1. Spartanburg District Four will maintain a five day face-to-face instructional model for staff and students.
2. Students' academic, social, emotional, mental health, food services, and health needs will be met during their time at school to the best of District Four's ability.
